

TOUR PLAN #1

Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage

Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage is an orphanage, nursery and breeding ground for wild Asian elephants located at Pinnawala village. Pinnawala is notable for having the largest herd of captive elephants in the world.

08.00 The babies are fed on milk in the mornings and allowed to range freely on the 12 acres large grassland.

10.00 Each morning and afternoon 14.00 the animals are walked 400 meters to the river Maha Oya for a two-hour bath.

Between 16.30 and 1800 in the evening the animals are taken to their stalls and tethered for the night.

After watching these beautiful huge creature you can enjoy an elephant ride out-side the orphanage.

Return to Colombo or you will be dropped off at the airport 2hours prior to Departure flight.

TOUR PLAN #2

Kandy Day Tour via Pinnawala

Start your journey after having breakfast at hotel and leave for Kandy via Pinnawla

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Visit spice gardens to feel the aroma of Sri Lankan spices

Upon arriving at great city of Kandy, you can do a city tour to explore the historic and scenic value.

Kandy Lake side walk, Temple of tooth, Royal Botanical Garden, Gem museum, Batik and silk factory visit. Experience some great shopping as well.

Return to Colombo or drop off at the airport for departure flight.

TOUR PLAN #3

Galle Day Tour

Pick you up from hotel and leave for Galle and you will be stopped at Kosgoda Turtle Farm. This is the best place to see sea turtles. Then proceed to Galle and enjoy the historic and scenic value. Visit Galle fort, Dutch fort, Galle museum, Old Dutch church, British Church.

Later proceed to see stilt fishing; this is a traditional method of fishing sitting on a stick.

Then leave to Hikkaduwa beach, this is another finest beach area and famous for its corals so you can do diving, snorkeling and relax at the beach.

Return to Colombo or proceed to airport for departure flight.

TOUR PLAN #4

Rathnapura Day Tour – Gem Land Tour

Pick you up from hotel and leave for Rathnapura. Rathnapura is famous for Gems but there is another sweet story behind Rathnapura. Rathnapura is famous for traditional sweets called “Jaggery” this is traditional palm candy made in Sri Lanka so Portuguese called this as “Rapadura”. It is believe that this is one of the stories behind gem city named as Rathnapura.

You can see the gem mines and how these precious stones are being done as Rubies/ blue sapphires, ect.,

After visiting the gem museum you can proceed too Colombo or drop off at the airport for departure flight.

TOUR PLAN #5

Anuradhapura Day Tour – History of Ceylon (Sri Lanka)

Pick you up from hotel and proceed to historic city of Anuradhapura. You will visit the **Sri Maha Bodhi** An offshoot of the historical Bodhi tree under which Buddha became enlightened was planted in Anuradhapura in 288 BC, **Abhayagiri Dagaba**, This is one of the most sacred Buddhist pilgrimage towns and extensive ruins in the world.

Ruwanwelisaya Stupa is considered a marvel for its architectural qualities.

Thuparamaya Collarbone of Buddha is enshrined in the chetiya of Thuparamaya. It is the first dagaba built in Sri Lanka.

Lovamahapaya Also known as Brazen Palace Lovamahapaya is a complex which was once a structure of its own class.

Jetavanaramaya This is the largest stupa in Sri Lanka. It was the third largest structure in the ancient world.

Mirisaveti Stupa It was built by King Dutugamunu after defeating King Elara. A legend associates it with the relics of Lord Buddha.

Lankarama This is a stupa constructed by King Valagamba in an ancient place. After this visit we go back to the hotel.

After visiting the gem museum you can proceed too Colombo or drop off at the airport for departure flight.

Further day tours can be arranged to Sigiriya/ Polonnaruwa/ Marawila/Mirissa – Whale watching, etc.,
