Guidelines for Abstract Submission

Key Dates:

- Abstract Submission Opens: 15th February 2025
- Submission Deadline: 30th May 2025
- ℎ Notification of Acceptance: 1st September 2025

Eligible Abstract Categories:

We welcome abstracts based on:

- Case reports / case series
- Research studies
- Audits

Submissions should be relevant to **Histopathology, Cytopathology, or other pathology-related disciplines**.

Abstract Preparation Guidelines

General Formatting Requirements:

- Language: English
- File Format: MS Word (2003 or later)
- Paper Size: A4
- Margins: 30 mm (all sides)
- Font: Times New Roman
- Line Spacing: Double
- Word Limit: Maximum 250 words (excluding headings and subheadings)
- Figures, tables, and references should not be included in the abstract.

Aspiring for the future

Abstract Structure:

Title

- Should be concise yet reflective of the scientific content.
- Bold, UPPERCASE, Font Size 12, Center-aligned. The Editorial Committee reserves the right to modify the title if necessary.

Author Information

- **Names:** Font Size **11**, **Bold**, **Center-aligned** (use lowercase letters except for initials and first letters of names).
- Initials: Each initial should be followed by a full stop and space.
- Do not include prefixes (e.g., Mr., Dr., Professor).
- **Presenter's name** should be **underlined**, and the **corresponding author** should be indicated with an asterisk (*).
- Leave one line space between author names and affiliations.

Affiliations

- Font Size 11, Italics, Center-aligned.
- If multiple institutions are involved, use **superscript numbering** for affiliations and link them to the respective author.
- Corresponding author's email should be included at the end.
- Leave two-line spaces between affiliations and the abstract body.

Abstract Content Formatting

For Research Abstracts:

- ♦ Introduction and Objectives
- Methodology (design, setting, methods, statistical methods, where applicable)
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusions

For Case Reports / Case Series:

- Introduction
- Case Report (clinical history, gross and microscopic pathology)
- Discussion
- ♦ Comments / Conclusions

Additional Formatting Guidelines:

✓ Acknowledgements: (if applicable) Limited to citing grants/funding sources in italics. One line space before acknowledgments.

✓ Keywords: Maximum of five, included under the heading 'Keywords:' One line space

✓ British Spelling must be used throughout.

✓ **Abbreviations** should be written in full at first mention (except for standard abbreviations).

✓ Non-English & Technical Terms should be italicized.

✓ Units: Use International System of Units (SI) with a space between the figure and the unit (e.g., 25 cm).

Abstract Submission Process

Submission Deadline: 30th May 2025, 4.00pm Sri Lankan time

Abstracts must be submitted **via the e-portal** on or before the deadline. Required documents for submission:

1 . Abstract with author names and affiliations

2 . Abstract without author names and affiliations

 \not If submitting multiple abstracts, each should be submitted separately.

 \triangle Late submissions, abstracts submitted in incorrect formats, or via alternative methods (email, hard copy) will NOT be accepted.

Abstract Review & Selection Process

Q Abstracts that do not adhere to the guidelines will be **rejected without review**.

♀ Conforming abstracts will undergo anonymous peer review.

 $Q_{\!\!\!S}$ All correspondence regarding **revisions and acceptance** will be directed to the **corresponding author** via email.

 \mathbb{Q} The Scientific Committee reserves the right to edit and standardize abstracts.

Conference Registration Requirement

• Accepted abstracts will be included in the **conference proceedings book** only if the **presenting author registers** for the conference on or before 30th September 2025.

Ethical Considerations

✓ Authors bear full responsibility for the content and ethical considerations of their work.

 \checkmark If the work has been previously **presented or published**, it **must** be disclosed in the abstract submission form (**this does not disqualify an abstract**).
