

CPSL and EAHP Lymphoma Tutorial

session: small B-cell lymphomas

Case: TVU17-14968

Clinical information: A 63 year old male patient presented with anemia and abdominal pain. Leucocytosis of $15.7 \times 10^9/l$ was noted with a IgM/D/lambda monoclonal lymphocytic component of 73%, CD5+, CD24+, CD10-, CD103-.

CT-scan showed splenomegaly (cranio-caudal size 23 cm) without further lymphadenopathy or hepatomegalie.

A bone marrow trephine was submitted
